HR professionals take part in acclaimed MBTI personality assessment course at UOWD

Twenty-two HR professionals took part in the UAE's first ever accreditation course in Myers-Briggs Type Indicator® (MBTI®), a universally recognized assessment tool to analyze personality type, which was offered at the University of Wollongong in Dubai (UOWD) recently.

The aim of this program was to accredit HR professionals and psychologists in utilizing the MBTI assessment at workplace, at home, or with friends. Dr. Lien Els - Associate Professor Human Resources, UOWD, coordinated the event.

The MBTI has a long history with more studies done and more extensive revisions than any other personality assessment tool. The Step I assessment identifies a person's whole type made up of four basic type preferences. The Step II assessment provides a more richly textured picture of type and behavior using 20 additional facets.
